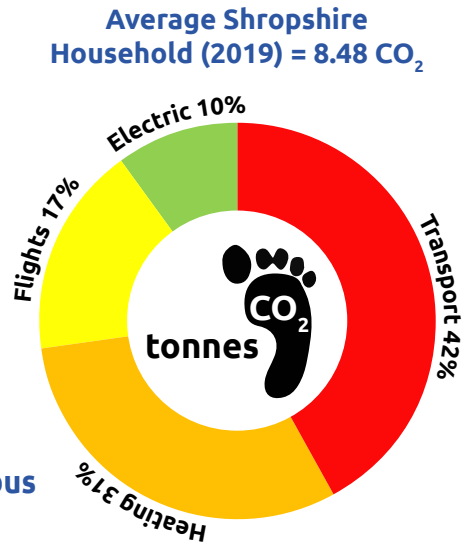

This is the carbon breakdown for the average Shropshire household:

This is what we can all do:

- Drive a less polluting car – share car journeys
- Better still walk, cycle, or take the bus
- Avoid air travel
- Make your home more energy efficient (\*)
  - make sure your loft is well insulated
  - use low energy appliances and LED light bulbs
  - don't leave appliances on standby
  - turn down the heating by a degree or two
- Use less – repair more often – and recycle
- Waste less food – eat more fruit and veg from Shropshire farmers
- Look after the natural world – plant trees – let hedgerows grow – and encourage wildlife
- Buy your electricity from a renewable energy supplier
